

Inter-University Task Week Rules 2nd Draft

- 1. Teams: Universities will enter as a team. There is no limit on team size, but teams do need to be declared at the start of the competition.
- 2. Each club will appoint a team captain who will be responsible for their teams flying.
- 3. There will be points scored for XC and progression. Each class will be treated as a separate competition, with prizes for each class. The points from each class will be combined to give the overall winner.
- 4. (XC) If more than one task is set then the pilot may select which task they fly. There is no need to declare which task is being flown, and the pilot is free to amend their choice at any time.
- 5. (XC) All flights will be considered as declared for the purposes of scoring.
- 6. A GPS logger or an IGC file from a PDA will be required to score XC points.
- 7. (XC) If a task is not completed it will be scored such that the highest score is used.
- 8. The XC points will be calculated producing an average score for the team.
- 9. In the event of bad weather preventing flying other tasks will be assigned at the discretion of the organisers. Rules for these tasks will be available separately.
- 10. Progression points will be awarded for the following:
 - o 1st Solo
 - o Silver Distance
 - o Silver Duration
 - o Gold/Diamond Distance
 - o Silver/Gold Height
 - o Bronze/XCE Field Landings
 - o Bronze Soaring Leg
 - o Bronze Flying Tests
 - o Bronze Exam
 - o Anything Else
